REFLECTION

A Christian View of Angels

What an Angel Is. An angel is a spiritual creature, a personal being without a body, appointed for the service of the divine church.

Bible Does Not Say Much About Angels. Moses writes nothing about the creation of the angels because.....he did not want to provide an opportunity for speculation. Our God did the right thing in that He did not permit many matters to be written; otherwise we would have despised what we now have and would have pried into what is beyond us.

Good Angels Are the Stronger. That the entire world is not a mass of flames, that all towns and villages are not lying in a heap of ruins, we owe to the working and doing of the good angels. They are far more sensible and wise than the evil angels, because they have a mirror into which they look, a mirror the devil does not have. It is called facies Patris, the face of our Lord God. This is why one good angel is far wiser than all the devils put together. The good angels are much mightier too; for they stand in the presence of Him whose name is Omnipotens, the Almighty.

Their Appearances Create Fear. The good angels bring terror; that is, they come with a certain majesty...so that the people to whom they come are frightened. Thus Mary is filled with fear upon seeing the angel (Luke 1:29)....But an evil angel creeps along smoothly and gently, like a serpent, until he has lured people into security and sin; then he departs, leaving horrible fear behind.

Angels at our Side Even in Death. You should be certain that angels are protecting you when you go to sleep, yea, that they are protecting you also in all your business, whether you enter your home or leave your home....Therefore even when you come to die, you should say that Christ will be with you and will have an unnumbered multitude of holy angels with him. You should know that angels are at your side not only in this life but also in death.
